# OLYMPIA

## Activities Available

### Leisure Pool Swim

Sessions are available on Mondays in our leisure pool, including waves and dive pool. These sessions are available for children between 8 and 17 years old, who are competent swimmers.

*COMPETENT SWIMMER, Scotland Safe Swimmer Award: Jump from poolside into 1.8 metre depth (head must fully submerge), Tread water for 30 seconds & attract attention, Swim 25 metres without stopping, Float on front and rotate onto back for 5 seconds each.*

### Lane Swimming

Public lane swimming is available in our 25m training pool. Sessions available on Thursdays.

### Family Pods

Enjoy your own private pod (7.20 metres x 5.15 metres) for up to 2 adults and 3 children. Sessions are held in the activity pool which is 1 metre deep and includes a selection of toys. ### Covid Procedures

- Always ensure social distancing.
- Face coverings should be worn when moving around the centre, unless exempt.
- Sanitation stations are available throughout the building.
- Colour scheme will operate to control sessions.
- Cubicles and lockers are in operation (but it is preferred that you come 'beach ready').
- At present showers are not available.
- One-way system around throughout the facility, including Changing Village and poolside.
- Give way to anyone making their way to poolside.
- Personal bags can be taken onto poolside provided they are not left at ground height. Customer toilets are in operation, one in and one out system.
- Maximum of 5 swimmers allowed per lane. You must swim clockwise in the lane.
- When leaving use one-way system to exit.

## Activities Available

### Fun Sessions in the Pool

Maximum of 4 x Families can attend (a family can be 2 adults and up to 3 children). Please refer to the child admission policy.

### Sports Hall

These activities are only available for young people from 5-18 years who attend with a group lead due to current Scottish Government Covid guidance. These sessions are not available for individual or family purchase.

- Bubble/Zorb Football - Maximum of 8 people
- Basketball - Maximum of 16 people
- Indoor Football - Maximum of 16 people
- Badminton - Maximum of 16 people

Equipment will be provided for all Sports Hall group bookings by Leisure & Culture Dundee, but group must select the respective activity they want to participate in when making the booking for planning and resource.

### Covid Procedures
