

## **Olympia accessibility**

The Olympia has many accessible features throughout the facility.

Accessible car parking is available in the adjacent multi storey car park.

Levels 4 to 13 have 2 disabled spaces each. Help point intercom is on level 4.

All door signs are in braille.

### **Ground floor**

External automatic access doors are located at each end of the Atrium to allow access from Gallagher Retail Park and Dundee City Centre.

Reception is designed with a low level section to allow wheelchair users better admittance to Reception staff.

Induction Loops are available, including activity classes.

Access route to the swimming pool is level with good corridor width and the double doors have a clear opening capable of allowing the passage of a wheelchair without having to use the second leaf.

The Changing Village is unisex and has 4 large changing cubicles, a Disabled Toilet and an Accessible Changing Room fitted with disabled toilet, shower, ceiling hoist, movable bench and privacy screen for carers.

The shower area includes one large access shower, is level with plenty of width and sensor controlled shower.

The Training Pool has a submersible platform lift and two built in step entry points for access to the pool. We provide 2 shower chairs for public use and permanent seating is available as a rest area.

The Activity Pool also has a submersible platform lift.

Leisure Pool entry is level followed by a gently angled slope, either on foot or by chair.

The Toddler Pool has broad stairs and handrails to allow a gradual access.

### **First floor**

Access route to the Café is either the stairs or the lift in the Atrium.

Spectator/viewing areas are on the first floor. All balustrades are stainless steel rails with clear toughened glass to allow viewing for everyone.

Fitness Studio and Activity Room are located on the first floor and can be accessed from the lift in the main building, close to the Reception.
