THE MCMANUS: DUNDEE'S ART GALLERY & MUSEUM

EXHIBITIONS

OUT OF THE FRAME: SCOTTISH ABSTRACTION

Continuing until Sun 28 May 2017 FREE Admission.

Rejecting traditional subject matter, abstraction gave artists the opportunity to explore colour, form and emotional expression in works that were no longer constrained by the picture frame. Revel in artworks by Wilhelmina Barns-Graham, Calum Innes and a major new acquisition by Victoria Morton.

SENSE OF PLACE

Continuing throughout 2017 FREE Admission.

How have Scottish artists represented the world around them? Drawn from Dundee's nationally significant fine art collection, this display focuses on landscape painting and includes work by the Glasgow Boys, Scottish Colourists, James McIntosh Patrick and Joan Eardley. Keep your eye open for changes as new works are hung to replace items going out on loan.



FIRE AND STONE

An exhibition exploring the archaeology of Monifieth Laws and the process behind creating contemporary responses to ancient metal and stone artefacts.



THE MARITIME QUARTER

A new permanent exhibition of ship models highlighting Dundee's rich maritime history and the City's links to the wider world. Including model sailing ships, war ships and half hulls, the exhibition will also feature some of the recently acquired DP&L models.
