## II ARTHURSTONE LIBRARY CAPITAL PROJECT

There was tabled an agenda note advising the Board of a request from Dundee City Council for Arthurstone Library to be closed for a four month period to allow implementation of a major capital project to provide community access to the upper floor of the building.
